It is also called the Silver Jubilee Clock Tower since it was built to commemorate the silver jubilee of Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wadiyar’s reign in 1927. Rising 75 feet, the tower is a mix of various architectural styles that have been ingeniously blended to create this masterpiece. It is square in shape and is predominantly Indo-Saracenic in style, with eaves and other details following Rajasthani style. The clock is 5 feet in diameter and is located a little below the top. Above it is a domed canopy that rests on a consoled base.
